## Dog Costume Sizing Guide

Sizing Guide:
Back: Measure length of pet's back from the base of the neck to the base of the tail. See below for estimating by breed. Neck: Measure the circumference of pet's neck for a snug fit. No need to add inches as you would with a collar. Chest/Girth: Measure girth around the broadest part of the chest and add 2".

Note: If the dog has a stout build, select one size larger.

| Small | $9 "-14 "$ | $16 "-20 "$ | $12 "$ |
| Medium | $10 "-16 "$ | $20 "-26^{\prime \prime}$ | $16 "$ |
| Large | $13 "-24 "$ | $25 "-32 "$ | $20 "$ |
| X-Large | $18 "-30 "$ | $30 "-38 "$ | $24 "$ |

Small: Boston Terrier, Jack Russell Terrier, Maltese, Pug, Silky Terrier
Medium: Bichon Frise, Beagle, Cocker Spaniel, Corgi, Scottish Terrier
Large: Brittany Spaniel, Bulldog, Collie, Schnauzer, Springer Spaniel
X-Large: Doberman Pinscher, German Shepherd, Golden Retriever, Labrador Retriever, Rottweiler
